Role Overview:

The Public Relations Committee shall have responsibility for managing relationships between the Rho House Association and Parents of undergraduate members, Lafayette College Campus, the Easton Community and Rho DKE Alumni.

The Committee shall consist of at least one Director, one undergraduate member elected by the actives, and such number of non Directors as the Board may determine. Terms shall be a minimum of five years of service, with no more than one member rotating in any given year to preserve institutional memory.

Role Responsibilities

The Committee's collective responsibilities are to:

- Provide training to undergraduates for publishing and maintaining the undergraduate website hosted by Lafayette
 - o Maintain a contact list of actives and their parents' contact information
- Plan and organize special parents events (i.e. new parents' orientation, commencement, Parents' Night/Weekend, Senior Farewell, etc.)
- Send congratulations cards recognizing achievement, and holiday cards to families of undergraduates
- Maintain rhodke.org with regular content updates
- Publishes the Rho News to all alumni, undergraduates, and parents at least twice a year. The Rho News should consistent of alumni news, chapter news, campus news, and DKE Int'l news.
- Maintain and update contact information for chapter members
- Remind brothers from the day they pledge until the day they die of their lifetime commitment to DKE and Lafayette College
